Behnken Receives Jefferson Cup

Theodore R. Behnken ('82), best known as Ted, was honored by Sigma Phi Epsilon's Board of Directors at the February meeting of the Carlson Leadership Academy with the presentation of the Jefferson Cup for Distinguished Alumni Service.

This award is presented annually at CLA to outstanding alumni who have given dedicated service for more than seven years to the Fraternity. Ted well exemplifies the cardinal principles of Sigma Phi Epsilon in his work as an alumnus of the Ohio Iota Chapter.

He has served for many years on the alumni board in various capacities, including his current position as treasurer. His major contributions to the chapter, however, have been in two areas. He has been an outstanding chapter counselor for four years, helping the chapter work through crises in leadership, establishing higher standards of excellence in scholarship and developing and maintaining quality programming.

His work on the Balanced Man Scholarship has been the crowning achievement of his efforts. The UT program is one of the best in the nation, largely through Ted's efforts. His continuing strength on the alumni board makes Ted Behnken a person well worthy of the Jefferson Cup for distinguished alumni participation.


Announcing the 1997 Sig Ep Alumni-Active Golf Outing
