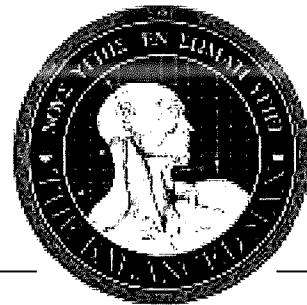

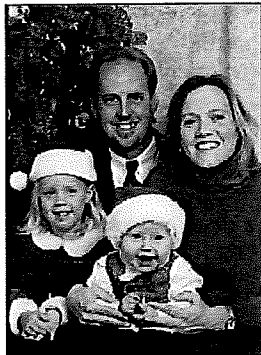

William Garrett Henry, M.D., a Chi Beta Chi, died on September 20, 2005. He was a prominent Toledo physician on the staffs of St. Vincent's, Toledo and St. Luke's Hospital. He was well-known as volunteer sports team doctor for many Toledo Public Schools teams and the University of Toledo collegiate sports program. His father David W. Henry was the first Dean of the College of Education at UT.

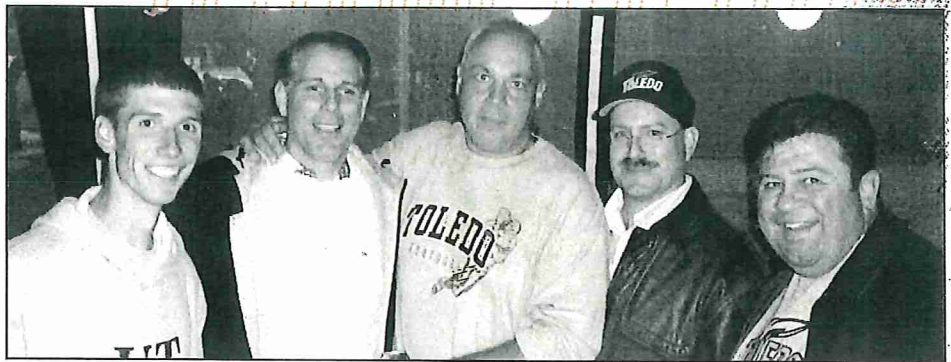
Thank You Brothers!
